

AUTUMN HANDICRAFT

Friends for Betty

This cute handicraft takes approx. 20 minutes.

What you need:

- * black, grey or brown paper (construction paper or another heavier paper) alternatively craft felt
- * scissors, glue
- * white crayon
- * wiggly eyes
- * wool, cotton wool
- * black, grey or brown pipe cleaner
- * one sock (black, purple, grey)

Stuff the sock from toes to heel tightly with cotton wool. Then use the pipe cleaner to close the sock; bend the ends of the cleaner to hooks so your bat can hold on to something. Cut off the remaining end of the sock. Now cut out wings and ears from the black craft paper. Draw some lines with the white crayon on the wings and ears for color highlighting. Glue them to the head and to the back of your bat. Of course your bat also needs eyes so glue the wiggly eyes to the head and you're done!

Now you can go look for a nice place to hang your bat on, for example a ceiling lamp or the coat rack.
